

## Half Fare Program Procedure

DCT will offer Half Fare for Disability, to rider's 65 years of age or older, Paratransit approved riders and to Medicare Card Holders on Fixed Route bus service.

Acceptable proof for qualifying for half fare for age may be any of the following: Government issued ID, a State ID, Driver's License, or a Medicare Card.

Acceptable proof for qualifying for half fare for disability may be any of the following: Medicare Card Holders, DCT issued half fare card. DCT will also honor half fare to individuals who have been approved by another transit agency/authority upon receiving a copy of the card at the DCT office. Individuals that receive V.A./Social Security Disability and have an Award Letter will qualify for half fare without a licensed medical professional approval, upon receiving a copy of the Award Letter at the DCT office.

Rider's that do not meet the above requirements but wish to apply for half fare can obtain an application via mail by calling DCT customer service line 740-363-3355 or they may print the application by going to DCT's website: [www.delcotransit.com](http://www.delcotransit.com). The application will need to be completed by a licensed medical professional in its entirety to be accepted. This includes Name, State License Number, Title, Agency, Phone Number and Address. If the application is not completed by the licensed medical professional, half fare will not be honored.

All applicants may bring the completed application and/or Social Security Award letter in person to the DCT office or send a copy by postal mail: 119 Henderson Ct. Delaware, Ohio 43015: fax 740-362-7603. Once DCT has received the completed application, the applicant will receive a Half Fare card. They will need to have the card with them when traveling on the bus. If the individual does not present his/her card to the driver, they will be required to pay full fare.
